Terms and conditions

Only Scientific Institutes for Research and Health Care (Istituti di Ricovero e Cura a Carattere Scientifico pubblici e privati, IRCCS) are eligible to apply.

In the same year simultaneous participation in proposals submitted in different EU transnational research calls, funded by the Ministero della Salute, is not allowed to Italian Research Investigators. In order to expedite the eligibility check process, the Ministry of Health will grant an eligibility clearance to the applicants prior to the submission of the pre-proposals. To this end, it is mandatory that the applicants fill out and return a eligibility check form through IRCCS Scientific Directorate using WFR System before submitting their pre-proposals to the Joint Call Secretariat.

It is mandatory that the completed form, is returned at least 10 working days before the pre-proposal submission deadline giving communication via W.F.R with Project Code E.R. Applicants will be sent a written notification of their eligibility status.

Specific exclusions

Allowable costs

Personnel (only temporary contracts/fellowship, max 50% of the requested fund)

2. Direct Costs (Consumables)

Consumables (no limit); animals (no limit); travel costs and subsistence allowances (max 10% of the requested fund); dissemination of results (publications, meetings/workshops etc. max 1% of the requested fund); data handling and analysis (no limit); (All according to national regulations). Travel expenses and subsistence allowances associated with training activities only linked to the project. Not allowed to external O.U. :subcontracts/additional. Transfer of money abroad is not allowed.

Other indirect costs are not eligible. Overheads (maximum 10% of the requested fund).

Science Foundation Ireland (SFI), Republic of Ireland

Terms and conditions

In addition to the CoEN mandatory eligibility criteria, Irish applicants must also satisfy National eligibility criteria:

The Ireland based partner must hold a PhD or equivalent qualification for at least 5 years post PhD by the pre-proposal deadline (please visit the SFI website for further details on equivalence).

The partner must:

- be a member of the academic staff of an eligible Research Body (permanent or with a contract that covers the period of the grant) OR
- be a contract researcher with a contract that covers the period of the grant, who is recognised by the eligible Research Body as an independent investigator and will have an independent office and research space for which he/she will be fully responsible for at least the duration of the SFI grant OR
- be an individual who will be recognised by the eligible Research Body upon receipt of the grant as an academic staff or as a contract researcher as defined above. The applicant does not necessarily need to be employed by the Research Body at the time of the application submission.

The partner is required to have demonstrated research independence through securing at least one peer-reviewed, independent research grants as a Principal Investigator or as a Co-Principal Investigator. Personal awards such as travel awards, career fellowships (which only include the salary of the PI and not the research team costs (i.e., salary for team member(s) & consumables etc.)) do not count as independent research grants.

The applicant must be a senior author (first, last or corresponding or in those fields where alphabetic order authorship is the norm, joint author) on at least 10 peer-reviewed scientific journal articles. Please note that only original research publications, and not review articles or other secondary research literature, are acceptable.

Applicants must ensure that proposals align with Science Foundation Ireland's legal remit and one, or more, of the 14 national Research Prioritisation areas.
